World Harvest Mission Receives Funding for School in Uganda

SACRAMENTO, CA – On Sunday January 11, 2004, the board of New Life Community Church in Fair Oaks California authorized funding for the construction of four blocks of classrooms at Bethany primary school in Kyaggwe, Uganda.

Located on a 25 acre campus owned by Africa Renewal Ministries in Uganda, Bethany primary school will be the first Christian primary school in the area and is expected to have an enrollment of over 100 students after the construction is completed. A WHM team will visit Uganda in September 2004 and help with the school construction.

Along with authorizing payments for the four classrooms, the Church board also authorized funds for a container shipment of sewing machines, computers, medical equipment, school supplies, as well as scholastic material.

On behalf of the World Harvest Mission board of directors, we want to extend our gratitude to New Life Community Church for this substantial investment in the future of Uganda. We would also like to appeal to other churches and our friends in the United States to partner with us on the “**Bunyiro primary school Water Well Project**” where over 800 students and staff members do not have a clean water source on their school campus. We need to raise \$2,500 to construct the well by December 2004, and any donation large or small will go a long way in helping us to reach that goal.

Thank you for standing with us. It is our belief that working together, we can improve the lives of those who are less fortunate in Uganda and Rwanda.
