New Water Wells:

Eighty percent of all illnesses in Uganda can be traced back to unclean water. Education and clean water are key to a healthy, sustainable life. Through generous partners, WHM has constructed 5 new water wells this year, *servicing an estimated population of 12,200 adults and children!* Each new water wells costs \$3,000.
