Greetings to you our friends:

Thank you for your continued love and support. Although it has been a while since we sent out a newsletter, you have always been in our prayers and the projects that you support have continued to grow and flourish. The children you sponsor have been promoted to higher grades, more water wells have been constructed at primary schools, and Mpala women's project has continued to train more ladies in sewing and knitting. Some of the ladies have left the center and have opened up their own businesses. As we make our way into the second half of this year, please enjoy this brief update and remember to pray for the safety of our brothers and sisters in Uganda, and for the amazing opportunities for ministry.

New Water Wells:

As of the end of June, WHM had received donations to complete at least four more water wells. Kyabaganyire water well sponsored by WILLITS UNITED MEHTHODIST CHURCH and residents of Willits, California, is near completion. The other three water wells are being donated through the efforts of our friend Jonathan Gunderson. For details visit Jonathans' website, www.seegundryrun.com. Lack of clean water in many of the towns and villages means the difference between life and death. Each new water wells costs \$3,500.

**Our Child Sponsorship Program:**

In Uganda, children at the primary school level start school at around the age of seven and school attendance for many of the children is a big challenge due to various illnesses, lack of clean water at the school, and lack of school fees (tuition). Some children start school late in life because they are forced to stay at home to work on their parents' farms, or to work in order to raise their own tuition. Through our WHM child sponsorship program, individuals, organizations and churches are supporting such children for \$25 dollar a month which helps us provide tuition, and uniforms. Through this program, you will become a friend to a child in poverty and your sponsorship will profoundly change the future of the child. We are still in need of sponsors.

Mission Trips:

Looking ahead, we are seeking volunteers who would like to travel to Iganga Uganda on a short or long term mission trip to assist in establishing bible study clubs at the schools where we have constructed water wells.
